Pee Wee– Year End Director’s Report

The U13 Leagues (SCHAL, CAHL and City) consisted of a total of 9 teams for the 2020-2021 season.

A total of 141 players registered and tried out to form the AA, CAHL and city leagues.

Pee Wee AA

- All evaluation skates and tryout games were ran and evaluated by independent 3rd parties
- 2 AA SCAHL teams were drafted (15 skaters and 2 goalies each) as per MHMHA guidelines
- Their seasons were cut short due to the pandemic

City League

73 players filled the rosters for the city league.

- The teams were drafted as per MHMHA rules to ensure a competitive league
- The playoffs were not conducted due to the current state of the world affairs
- Their seasons were cut short due to the pandemic

Tournaments

Nothing to report as the season was not a conventional one.

Zone Players

Redcliff, Irvine, Bow Island and Oyen all contributed zone players to the season and in turn we reciprocated player to fill their remaining teams as required.

Work is underway with Redcliff, Bow Island and Irvine to help streamline the player movement process in the future.

City Refunds

- A task force was put forth to calculate the refunds based on the below criteria and came up with a refund for the U13 city league of up to \$359.96, this total includes MHMHA using up to 60K of reserve money.
- Total fees paid by members of that league.
- Expenses for each different division were determined taking into account:
 - Amount of ice used
 - Administrative costs
 - Referee costs
 - Hockey Alberta/carding costs

Rep Refunds

- The rep refunds are handled by the teams themselves as they run their own accounts.
