Please note the try out fees are included in the above rates for all the travel teams. Tryout Fees are **NON-REFUNDABLE**. SEAC tryout fees are \$250.00. MHMHA tryout fees are \$200.00.

Females wanting to try out for the elite stream U13 (Pewee) AA, U15 (Bantam) AA and U18 (Midget) AA in Lethbridge, must obtain the appropriate paperwork to attend try outs. Location and dates of try outs to be determined. Please reach out to Lethbridge Minor Hockey for more information.

Registration information:

1) FAMILY DISCOUNT:

\$50 is given for the 3rd child registered, and \$100 for the 4th child registered.

2) NEW PLAYERS:

All families are required to complete the online Respect in Sport course. This costs approximately \$12.00 and is an online interactive presentation and will take approximately one hour to complete. To Register: <https://hockeyalbertaparent.respectgroupinc.com/secure/>. Once this course is completed, we require you to email a copy of the **birth certificate** and **health care** number of your child to: info@mhmha.ca. **You will not be considered registered until we have these copies in our office.** If you have already completed the RIS course for another child and is up to date, you do not have to redo the course, however, go into your Hockey Alberta profile, and add a participant to link the new player. Call the office for details.

3) LOCAL PLAYERS REGISTERING:

All U11, U13, U16 and U18 players wanting to tryout for a MHMHA travel team (AA/CAHL), will start at the highest level and will be placed accordingly. All SEAC (U15 AAA, U15 AA, and U17 AAA) players not selected to a AAA/AA team will be added to CAHL evaluations. **MHMHA “caps” how many CAHL teams there are, and players not placed on a CAHL team will be placed in the assessment group to be placed on a city league team.**

4) ZONE PLAYERS:

Registration and the try out fee are required by MHMHA by June 30, 2024. If after June 30th, tryout fees will be \$100 more:

Once a zone player makes the team the remainder of registration fees will be required.

5) FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

JUMPSTART - Applications must be completed online only at: [Home | Jumpstart \(canadiantire.ca\)](#)

There will be no manual submissions for this program you must apply online.

To receive early bird rate, proof of application must be submitted to the MHMHA office by June 30, 2024. You must also start the online registration process through TeamSnap. Once the applicant receives confirmation of the amount they will receive, the office will require a copy of the acceptance letter to complete the registration and adjust the fees in TeamSnap.

Arrangements for the remaining balance must be online through TeamSnap with credit card or at the office with a post-dated cheque for September 1, 2024, and October 15, 2024.

6) **AA/CAHL/RMFHL Teams**

Will be treated as a travel team on a user pay basis. **User pay can be explained as the Registration fees are credited to the teams. League, administration, carding, ice fees, etc. are debited down and once the registration credits are “used up” teams will be responsible for all remaining associated costs. Some of these costs are ice, referee costs, etc. This may mean additional fundraising efforts, or the collection of monthly fees as determined by the teams.**

7) **PAYMENT OPTIONS:**

Registration is done through TeamSnap only. At the time of Registration, you can choose to pay your registration fees in full OR you can choose to pay your fees in installments (this is the option TeamSnap is defaulted to), and it will only charge your credit card a \$50 deposit, then split the remaining balance of your fees between September 1st and October 15th. These fees will automatically come of your credit card used to register.

If you do not have credit card to pay fees, you must still do the registration through TeamSnap, however, your registration will not be complete until you come into the office with payment for the deposit and post-dated checks for the remaining balance of your fees. If you do not have post-dated checks, you will need to pay the full balance with cash only. **Any NSF checks or declined credit card payments will be charged an additional \$40 bank fee.**

Should you require extra time to pay, please contact the MHMHA office.

8) **RESPECT IN SPORT – PARENT:**

Parents are required to complete the Respect in Sport program. Certification in the Respect in Sport program is valid for up to four seasons and is associated with a May 1 expiry date. Please check your Respect in Sport account to see if you are required to recertify. If this is not up to date, players will not be permitted on the ice until it's completed

9) **FIRST TIME FEMALES:**

First time females who have never played hockey, the registration fee will be \$350 (**this is for city league only – this does not apply to RMFHL travel hockey**). Please ensure you contact the office to make the adjustment on your TeamSnap account.

10) **U9 and U11 CITY LEAGUES:**

U9 (Novice) and U11 (Atom) are decided on skill set. Once evaluations are completed your child could be moved at the discretion of the evaluator between A and B.

11) **COACHES:**

As per the Medicine Hat Minor Hockey Association Board of Directors, Intervention Record Check and Police Vulnerable Sector Checks are required for any new coaches and any coaches who have not completed either check in the past 3 Seasons. If you are Police or RCMP, you are exempt. As per Hockey Alberta, any coach/volunteer stepping on the ice, is required, at minimum, to complete the Respect in Sport – Activity Leader program. This certification is valid for up to four seasons and is associated with a May 1 expiry date.
